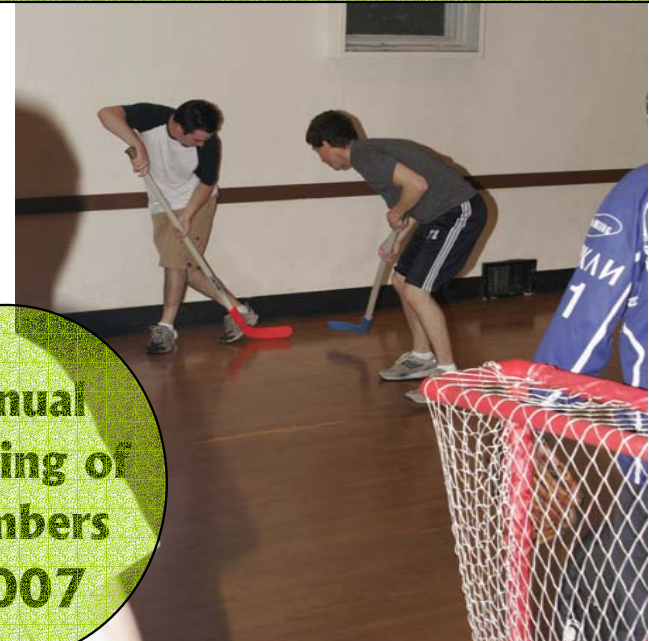

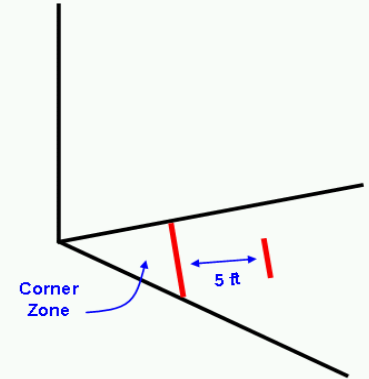

**Report of the Board of Directors for the Year 2007**

During 2007, the Club continued to find ways to truly make our playing environment a fun, friendly and safe place by experimenting with the "corner rule". Frustration and physical play as a result of two players battling for a ball lodged in a corner had elevated over the years.

The corner rule stipulates that the first player to get to the corner obtains the ball and that the opposing player must stand five feet away while the ball is put back into play. After a period of adaptation by players, the corner rule has proven successful in improving our playing environment.



In addition to holding its annual open house night at the end of August 2007, the Club reached out to the community by participating in the first All Sports and Fitness Expo held in October 2007 by the Champlain Valley Exposition. During this two-day event, volunteer club members played two demonstration games and other club members were available at the Club's booth to provide information and answer questions from the public.
